



## Osseo Reserve Program

The Osseo Police Department relies on our dedicated Reserve Police Officers to take care of many things in our city that don't require the attention of a sworn police officer. Our Reserve Officers provide additional personnel at city-sponsored events to assist with general security, traffic direction, and public relations. Reserve Officers also conduct uniformed patrolling of our city on an "observe and report" basis in a marked squad car. This gives us an extra set of eyes in our city and helps with keeping a police presence at peak times for criminal activity. Reserve Officers have also proven to be essential in their on-call capacity to help with natural disasters and major emergencies. Reserve Officers also assist our sworn officers with calls for motor vehicle accidents, medicals, domestics, crowd control, prisoner transports, and more. Our Reserve Officers are essential to keeping our police department running smoothly.

Our Reserve Officers are provided essential training to perform their duties, including field training reserve officer training courses offered by the Hennepin County Sheriff's Office. They are also included in many of our inner department training sessions. We encourage our Reserve Officers to grow within their positions through formal and on-the-job training!

## Medicine Drop-Box

The Osseo Police Department is accepting unwanted and unused medications from residents. The Osseo Police Department has set-up a medicine drop-box in its lobby located at 415 Central Ave. The box is an easy, environmentally safe way for Osseo-area residents to safely dispose of any unused or expired prescription medications.



The Osseo Drop Box is accessible, Monday through Thursday 7:30am till 5:00pm and Friday 7:30am till 11:30am in a secure and monitored location. Household prescription medications, over-the-counter medicines, vitamins/supplements, and pet medications will be accepted. No needles, sharps or syringes will be accepted.

## What's Happening in your neighborhood?

### Incidents:

Traffic stop - Near the intersection of County Road 81 and Central Ave. An officer conducted a traffic stop for a vehicle with no headlights on. The officer found the driver to not have a MN drivers license and was suspended in their home state. The party was issued a citation for not having a MN DL.

PD Accident – Intersection of County Road 81 and Jefferson Hwy. An Officer was dispatched to an accident that had occurred. There were no injuries related to the crash. A vehicle had slid through a stop sign and made contact with a stopped vehicle at the intersection. Both vehicles were driven away. A state accident report was completed.

Vehicle Lockout - 100 Blk of 3d St Ne – Officer was dispatched for a party locked out of their car. The officer was able to open the car without issue.

Parking complaint – 500 blk of Central Ave. An officer observed a vehicle in violation of the city's 24 hour parking ordinance. The officer chalked a tire on the vehicle and followed up. After 24 hours the vehicle had not moved and was issued a citation for the parking violation. After 48 hours the vehicle had still not moved, citation still on the car, the vehicle was impounded and towed to a local tow yard.

Fall – 500 blk of 2nd St SE. Our officer received a call that a party had fallen and needed assistance. Our officer arrived on scene and assisted the party back into their wheelchair. The officer was then cleared by North Ambulance.

Traffic stop – 200 blk of Central Ave. An officer observed a vehicle displaying registration that had expired a year and half ago. The officer confirmed the expiration date and conducted a traffic stop. The driver was issued a citation for the registration.

### Accidents:

PD Accident – Intersection of County Road 81 and Jefferson Hwy. An Officer was dispatched to an accident that had occurred. There were no injuries related to the crash. A vehicle had slid through a stop sign and made contact with a stopped vehicle at the intersection. Both vehicles were driven away. A state accident report was completed.
