Information for all Arts Classes

- Program meets the Osseo Community Center, 415 Central Avenue, Osseo, MN.
- Pre-registration and liability waiver required. Return original form to Osseo City Hall, 415 Central Avenue, Osseo, at least 7 days before the start of the first program your child will participate in.
 - Registrations will be accepted on a firstcome, first-served basis, and programs may fill up. Registrants will be notified and fees refunded if their registration cannot be accommodated.
 - Discounted "Resident" rates are subsidized by Youth Recreation funds in the city's budget. These rates are available on a firstcome, first-served basis for Osseo, Minnesota residents only, as long as funds remain available.
 - Refunds and registration changes will be accepted up to 2 weeks (14 days) before the first day of the program. After this point, no registration changes or refund requests can be accommodated.

Pre-School Art Exploration Classes

Young children (ages 2-5) and their caregivers will get the opportunity to use a variety of art materials and processes to learn and create. Each class starts with a story that will lead into the project and get the creative minds flowing. Parents have no fear letting your child create art and get messy - the mess stays behind and you and your child get to bond while creating a fun art project to take home. Class time from 12:30 - 1:30pm. *Limit of 12 students per session - not including parent.*

CRAZY CONSTRUCTION

Parents will help their children construct crazy structures using cardboard, bottles, straws, paper, and other recyclables. This is a fun class that allows children to tape glue or staple (with parents help) items together in a fun and creative way all while exploring some basic principles of architecture.
