Not including any permanent features requiring major removal efforts, such a concrete foundation

_____ The abutting landowner shall be responsible for the maintenance of any private improvement located within the boulevard or unopened right-of-way. Any unmaintained private improvements shall be deemed to be a nuisance.

_____ Outdoor displays, including sidewalk sales and sandwich board signs, may only be displayed during business hours.
