The 2019 Construction Season is Getting Underway!

The Osseo City Council awarded this project to Asphalt Surface Technologies on May 13th. Construction is anticipated to start around June 17th and be complete by October.

The project will reconstruct portions of 1st Avenue NW, 7th Avenue SE and the alley between 3rd Street NE-2nd Street NE and Central Avenue-1st Avenue NE. Street reconstruction will include surface reclamation, reconstructing storm sewers, partial replacement of curb and gutter, and the addition or repair of sidewalk. The project will also consist of milling and overlay portions of 6th Street NW, 6th Street NE, 5th Street NE, 4th Street NW, 3rd Street NE, and 2nd Street NW. Milling and overlaying will include removing the top layer of asphalt from the streets and paving a new layer of asphalt.

Tree Removals and Replacement

Trees that are scheduled for removal will be marked with a pink ribbon. Please make certain you are aware of any tree removals that will occur adjacent to your property. It is expected that tree removals will begin as early as June 17th.

Trees that are removed as a part of the project are eligible for replacement according to the City's tree replacement policy. If you have a tree removed and choose to participate in the program, you can choose a replacement tree from a selection provided by the City. City staff will work with you to find a suitable planting location on your property.

Sprinkler Systems & Invisible Fences

If you have a sprinkler system or an underground invisible pet fence on your property, please contact the project's construction observer. They will provide you flags that you can use to mark the locations of these items.

Street Parking

Vehicle access to driveways will be provided at the beginning and end of each working day. If there becomes a time where access cannot be provided during these times, you will be notified 24 hours in advance.
