# City of Osseo City Council Work Session Meeting Item

Agenda Item: Discuss Revised City Facilities Options

#### Background:

The Council held a work session on July 31, 2023, to discuss the current state of the City's aging City Hall and Public Safety building. At the meeting, Staff discussed the issues surrounding the current facility and the need to consider a rehabilitated or completely new facility soon. The current building was originally constructed in the 1960s and is outdated with aging utilities, inadequate ADA entrances and usable spaces, no windows in the Staff office area, water drainage issues, and insufficient space to house the Police Department's growth. Additionally, the Fire Department space does not fit the current industry standards, and the entire facility does not currently meet the community's service needs, nor will it meet the future service needs of the community.

The Council gave direction at that work session to bring forward a proposal to work with a local architecture firm to conduct a facility needs assessment. The Council approved a proposal from Oertel Architects, through local firm Rochon, to conduct the study at the August 14, 2023, Council meeting. Since then, Staff has met with representatives from Oertel Architects several times to begin the process of examining the current facilities, discuss with Department Heads the future requirements and service demands, and develop concept options for the City Council to consider.

On January 29, 2024, the Council held a work session to discuss the facility's needs and gave Staff feedback on the designs proposed. Staff and Oertel took the feedback and will be presenting revised options. Department heads will be in attendance to answer any questions from the Council.

#### **Discuss Available Funding Options:**

In addition to the City bonding for the project costs, Staff intends to work with local legislators to seek State bonding money as part of the overall financing of this project. Staff has already had initial discussions with local representatives and senator to provide some information on the pending bonding money ask. Additionally, other funding sources will need to be examined, including a local option sales tax, which would generate revenue that could offset project costs.

#### **Recommendation/Action Requested:**

The recommendation is for the City Council to carefully explore the information presented in the work session and reach a consensus about how the City should proceed with this project.

### **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

Oertel Architects was contacted by the City of Osseo to perform a facilities needs study for the City Government Offices, Public Works facility, and the building at Sipe Park. We toured the buildings with staff, reviewing both space and building shortcomings. With the city government offices being the primary focus, Oertel and City staff toured three facilities at neighboring cities. These tours helped guide conversations and frame the space needs study.

#### **Facilities Toured:**

Champlin Municipal Center - Combined City Hall, Police Department, and Fire Department. The City Hall is an older building that has been added on and remodeled several times. Public Works facility on same site.

New Hope City Hall and Police Department - Combined City Hall and Police Department. Recently completed ground up new building. Adjacent fire station and city park on same site.

Fridley Civic Campus - Combined City Hall, Police Department, and Fire Department. Recently completed ground up new building. Public Works facility on same site. Fridley Community Park across the street.

The goal of this study is to address the needs of Osseo's existing municipal buildings and help lay out potential solutions. This packet will cover four different design options that address the City Government building with an opinion of probable cost for each option. Additionally, the needs for small improvements at the Public Works facility and the Sipe Park are addressed and include cost estimates.

The design team at Oertel worked alongside city staff throughout the study to implement the city's priorities and values while maintaining a strong relationship to design best practices. The study provides professional input and design-based solutions that can guide the City of Osseo in future planning endeavors. Cost estimating services in this study were complete by Rochon Corporation.

# Design Option A - Remodel + Addition (Police at Press)

To reduce construction cost, an option was developed that removed one city service from this building. In this scenario, the Police Department was removed from the program and will be housed at the Osseo Press building. The existing city hall has two additions that partially wrap around a split level city hall. This makes remodeling the existing building challenging. Due to space limitations on site some concessions need to be made:

- City Hall, Fire Support, and main entry additions made to exg. building
- Fire Apparatus Bay remains back in style
- Library moves to the basement







# Design Option B - Remodel + Addition (Community Center at Boerboom Park)

The existing city hall has two additions that partially wrap around a split level city hall. This makes remodeling the existing building challenging. The library and dispensary will be housed at the Osseo Press building. Due to space limitations on site some concessions need to be made:

- City Hall, Fire Support, and Police Garage additions made to exg. building
- Fire Apparatus Bay remains back in style
- Community Center and Council Chambers are relocated to new building at Boerboom



# Design Option C - New Construction (Police at Press)

By demolishing the existing city hall, a new building can be better optimized to fit the programmatic needs and best practice design principles. To reduce construction cost, the Police Department and will be housed at the Osseo Press building. Some notable elements of this approach:

- All programs located on first level at grade
- Fire Apparatus Bay remain back-in style, but has gained more depth
- Community Center, Council Chambers, and Library all remain community facing and apart of city hall





SECOND FLOOR PLAN





# Design Option D - New Construction (Community Center at Boerboom Park)

By demolishing the existing city hall, a new building can be better optimized to fit the programmatic needs and best practice design principles. To maximize the existing site, the community center and council chambers is relocated to a new building on Boerboom Park. The library and dispensary will be housed at the Osseo Press building. Some notable elements of this approach:

- Big 3 programs within same building and located on first level at grade
- Fire Apparatus Bay remain back-in style, but has gained more depth




