The 2018 Construction Season is Getting Underway!

The Osseo City Council awarded this project to Asphalt Surface Technologies on May 14. Construction is anticipated to start around June 4 and be substantially complete in October.

The project will reconstruct portions of 4th Street NE, 4th Avenue NE, 6th Street NE, and the alleys between 2nd Avenue-3rd Avenue and 5th Avenue-6th Avenue. Street construction will include surface reclamation, reconstructing storm sewers, partial replacement of curb and gutter, and the addition or repair of sidewalk.

Tree Removals and Replacement

Trees that are scheduled for removal will be marked with a pink ribbon. Please make certain you are aware of any tree removals that will occur adjacent to your property. It is expected that tree removals will begin as early as June 4th.

Trees that are removed as a part of the project are eligible for replacement according to the City's tree replacement policy. If you have a tree removed and choose to participate in the program, you can choose a replacement tree from a selection provided by the City. City staff will work with you to find a suitable planting location on your property.

Sprinkler Systems & Invisible Fences

If you have a sprinkler system or an underground invisible pet fence on your property, please contact the project's construction inspector. They will provide you flags that you can use to mark the locations of these items.

Street Parking

Vehicle access to driveways will be provided at the beginning and end of each working day. If there becomes a time where access cannot be provided during these times, you will be notified 24 hours in advance.

During construction there will be significant construction traffic within the project site that may restrict your ability to drive through the area. To keep everyone safe we ask that you please consider alternate routes during construction.
