Sewer Maintenance Update

Insituform Technologies USA, LLC will begin installing the sewer main liners beginning on Wednesday, November 2. This work will take place at various locations throughout the City and you may not see work taking place near your property right away. The work being performed is weather dependent and cold weather may briefly interrupt the Contractor's progress.

Door Hangers

The Contractor will notify individual property owners with door hangers the day prior to liner installation. **Please check your front or side doors for this notice at the end and beginning of each day.** The door hangers will notify you when the sewer liner installation is going to impact your sewer service lateral. During this timeframe the Contractor will ask you to reduce water usage to help prevent sewage backups. Please do not use bathtubs, dishwashers, or washing machines during this time. Heavy water usage during this work could cause sewage backups. Sewer liner installation is normally completed in one day and once completed you can return to using water normally for the remainder of the project.

Preparing for Liner Installation

You may notice an odor outside if you are near the lining process. To prevent this odor from getting inside your house or building you should pour approximately one gallon of water down all floor drains or rarely used sinks, tubs or toilets. This will restore the water barrier between your plumbing fixtures and the sewer main which can dry out during long periods of inactivity. **If you have any plumbing concerns during this project you should contact the contractor at (612) 328-3958 before calling a plumber.**

Apartment Buildings

During the liner installation, the Contractor normally requests that residents reduce water usage for the day. This prevents sewer back ups from occurring while the sewer main is out of service. However, with apartment complexes the number of families using water at the same time can be significant. For this reason, the Contractor will work with the property managers to shut off the water to the buildings for approximately 6 hours. During this period residents will not have any water within their units. Once the water is turned back on you can return to using water normally for the remainder of the project.
